My Little Shadow, Fairy Tale Ballet, and Little Prima Ballerina

Students in these levels may wear whatever makes them comfortable. We suggest a leotard, tights (if they're willing), skirt / tutu, and proper ballet slippers.

Suggested level colors: Little Prima Ballerina: light pink

Attire for Ballet 1-5

We prefer our level 1 and up students wear proper ballet attire, including a leotard (see suggested-but not required-colors below), tights (not required until Ballet 2), and ballet slippers, and hair in a bun (required for level 3 and up)

Suggested leotard colors: Little Prima Ballerina: Light pink Ballet 1: White Ballet 2: Turquoise Ballet 3: Purple Ballet 4: Magenta Ballet 5: Navy Blue

Tap Classes (including Ballet/Tap & Jazz/Tap combo) Tap shoes are required.

Suggested tap shoe colors: Tac on Tap: Tan Little Tapping Ballerina: Tan Ballet/Tap 1: Tan Tap/Jazz 2: Black or Tan Tap & Jazz Tap 2: Black / Tan Tap 3: Black Tap 4: Black

Broadway, Lyrical, Jazz, Turns & Leaps

Comfortable dance attire. Suggested: tan tights, dance shorts, leotard, dance paws (lyrical/jazz/turns and leaps), Jazz shoes (Broadway /jazz).

<u>Boys Ballet</u>

Black Jazz or Ballet slippers. Comfortable workout attire (suggested: Black pants and black top).

Attire for Hip Hop

Comfortable attire. Suggested: leggings, t-shirt/top, and clean sneakers (to not track dirt into studio)

Crop tops with exposed bare midriffs are not allowed.

EVALUATIONS

We recognize our students' desire to reach and achieve personal goals. To help promote these goals and create a sense of comradely and leadership, we offer an evaluation program. This program consists of a ranked Ballet skirt system, much like you would see with Karate Belts. The color of a skirt indicates a dancer's ability to correctly demonstrate and/or portray their understanding of specific dance steps expected of each level. Each step forward represents a further accumulation of skills and knowledge.
